Job Description:

The Garden Intern will work with the small, dedicated staff of Downtown Greens to complete special projects and assist with ongoing garden programs. The Intern will learn hands-on organic gardening skills. The interest, initiative, and experience of the Intern will define and potentially expand the responsibilities for this position.

Responsibilities:

- **70% of the time: Spearhead a special project, possibilities including:**
 - Assist the youth program leaders during the months of April-October {Areas of study: *Education, Sciences, ...*}
 - Come visit and create a special project with us!
- **30% of the time: Help keep the community greenspace running smoothly**
 - Garden tasks: watering, weeding, and mowing, etc.

Job Qualifications:

- Experience using a lawnmower and weed wacker a must. Knowledge of basic maintenance required.
- A demonstrated interest in urban agriculture, permaculture, and/or organic gardening.
- Highly motivated individual capable of working independently without supervision.
- Experience leading volunteers and working with people from diverse socioeconomic backgrounds.
- We are particularly looking for knowledgeable, open-minded, and friendly people to apply for this position.
